Join us with Shelterbox to learn how they support crisis situations around the world and help people locally survive with their “EMERGENCY DISASTER RELIEF”.

A lot of things go on around the world all the time – natural disasters, war, uprisings etc. – which brings people to a situation where they have no home, no food, no personal items etc.

Shelterbox responds to these crisis situations with a set-up that fulfills whatever is most needed.

Everyone deserves a place to call home. It is a human right and the first step towards recovery after disaster.
We want to see a world where no family is left without shelter after disaster.
By providing emergency shelter and tools for families robbed of their homes by disaster, we’re transforming despair into hope.



ShelterBox began in 2000 as a Cornish Rotary Club’s millennium project. With the support of Rotary members and clubs around the world, ShelterBox grew to become an internationally recognised, independent disaster relief organisation. Vision: “No one without shelter after disaster”

Since 2012, ShelterBox and Rotary have been official Project Partners in disaster relief.
